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Abstract

Presenting content about Twenty years after the launch of the FodoArk project, Joel Chattory has photographed 18,000 species of animals. He increasingly realizes that conservation, central to the project, has never been more urgent. In the age of catastrophe, advanced science and new evidence from cities and communities destroyed by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD are reshaping our understanding of life and death of the ancient Romans. A mission to protect the world's rarest orchid, amid an extinction crisis, sees a courageous botanist transform his vast flower collection into a scientific treasure trove. A mysterious dome-like forest in the deep wetlands of Florida's remote areas – towering cypress trees form an ecological wonder. A hidden highway in the night sky is revealed, offering a new way to capture invisible traffic above one of the world's busiest skies. A rare opportunity to photograph a giant panda – to capture the famous Chinese polar bear, the inventive photographer first had to find it.
